Project Description (300 words max)	The celebration of World Poetry Day has become one of the classic projects on the cultural calendar of Granada city. This year our local slogan is twofold: on the one hand, "the dawn of poetic spring in Granada", and on the other, "marking a decade as a UNESCO Creative City". And at the same time, it stands as the foremost annual initiative led by Granada in partnership with some of our fellow UNESCO Cities of Literature.
	This 2024 edition will bring together up to 100 poets on March 21. It will consist of two blocks of public readings; the morning readings will take place in a public space linked to the University of Granada or to the City Hall, and the afternoon readings will occur simultaneously in 15 independent bookstores, following the same pattern of past celebrations.
	And again, in the same line as in previous years, we will be offering to all the participating cities the open poster designed by Granada UNESCO City of Literature, so as to be utilized at your best convenience.

	We will also compile the events organized by the cities partaking in the 2024 WPD festivities with the aim of composing a joint international press release as one of our
	key models for the dissemination of this collaborative project. Furthermore, we encourage cities to orchestrate diverse events or activities on the occasion of World Poetry Day celebrations, and welcome their initiatives with open arms.
